

8. Entering Cyprus for approved applicants of Immigration Permits

(only for individuals that have already been approved by the Civil Registry and Migration Department of the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Cyprus)

1.	<p>Visa application form</p> <p>One fully completed visa application form signed by the applicant (both parents or legal guardians in the case of minors).</p>	Original
2.	<p>One recent passport sized photograph (3 x 4 cm)</p> <p>Attached to the application form (looking forward, white colour background).</p>	Original
3.	<p>National passport</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid for at least three months longer than the validity of the visa being applied for; • A copy of the passport, including first and last pages and <u>all</u> pages bearing visas or stamps; • if the applicant has an old passport, this needs to be presented as well (original and a copy, including first and last pages and all pages bearing visas or stamps). 	Original + Copy
4.	<p>Immigration Permit</p> <p>Original Immigration Permit under Category A, B, C, D, E, or F, or under Regulation 6(2) issued by the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Cyprus or a letter (original or copy) from the Ministry of Interior of the Republic of Cyprus stating that the applicant's application for Immigration Permit has been approved.</p> <p>If the immigration permit you are providing belongs to your spouse or parent, please also submit:</p> <p>Original Marriage certificate, or original notarial certificate of marriage legalized the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of China and the Embassy of Cyprus. Copy of marriage certificate if married in Cyprus. If married in any other European country, duly legalized copy of marriage certificate. (if spouse)</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Original Notarial certificate of family relationship, legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs China and the Embassy of Cyprus in China, accompanied by an English translation.</p>	Original or Copy

5.	Flight reservation and/or itinerary of travel arrangements Tickets should not be purchased before the visa is issued.	Original or Copy
6.	Hukou (only for Chinese nationals) Original and copy of “Hukou” (all information pages) and English translation (only for Chinese nationals); AND original residence permit, copy of this and translation in English, if different from Hukou.	Original + Copy
<p>For minors only (under the age of 18):</p> <p>ALL THREE DOCUMENTS FOR THE MINORS (Certificate of Permission, Kinship and Birth Certificate) MUST BE LEGALISED BY THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF CHINA AND THE EMBASSY OF CYPRUS IN CHINA AND ACCOMPANIED BY AN ENGLISH TRANSLATION (when the parent is not in China, the Certificate of Permission needs to be attested by the relevant authorities in the country of residence).</p>		
7.	<p>Certificate of permission to travel</p> <p>When the minor is travelling alone or with one parent only: Original ID Card and certificate of permission to travel from the parent, or legal guardian not travelling, clearly stating the destination purpose of travel and time period for which the permission is granted.</p> <p>When the minor is travelling alone: Original ID Card and certificate of permission to travel from both parents or legal guardians, clearly stating the destination, purpose of travel and time period for which permission is granted.</p>	Original
8.	<p>Certificate of family relation</p> <p>Certificate of family relation, or proof of guardianship (kinship) clearly identifying both parents or legal guardians and also original ID Cards of both parents or legal guardians.</p>	Original
9.	Birth certificate of the minor	Original
